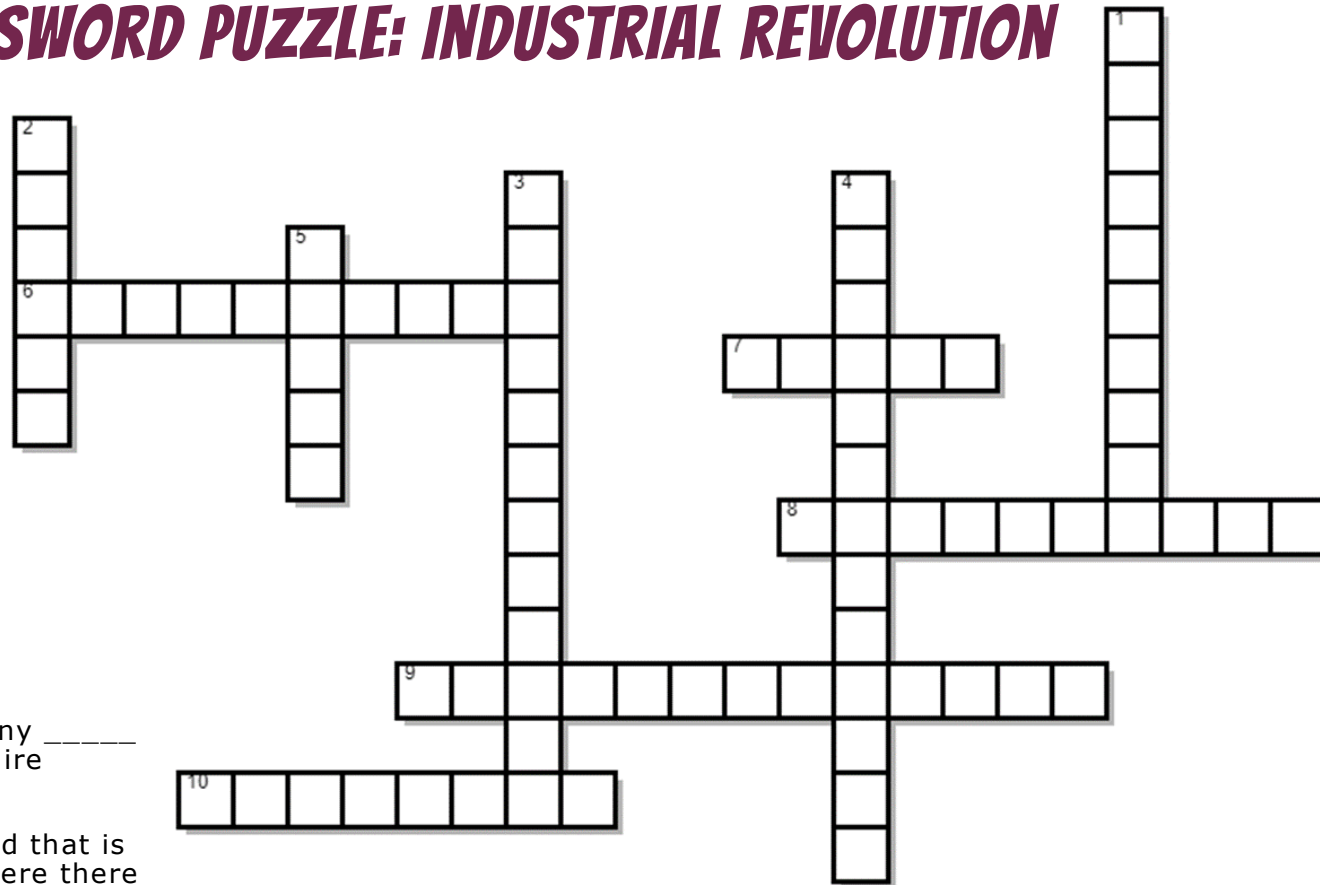




## CROSSWORD PUZZLE: INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION
