Factors of production are the things that are used together to make an object to be sold. These include all the different resources that are part of a product and all the systems needed to make it.

LABOR

The people who do the work

LAND

The natural resources, like farmland and rivers

CAPITAL

The human-made items necessary for production, like factories and machines

ENTREPRENEURSHIP

The people and systems in place that connect the other factors and grow the business

The factors of production are always the same.
But as time passes and technology changes, the resources, jobs, items, and systems change.
