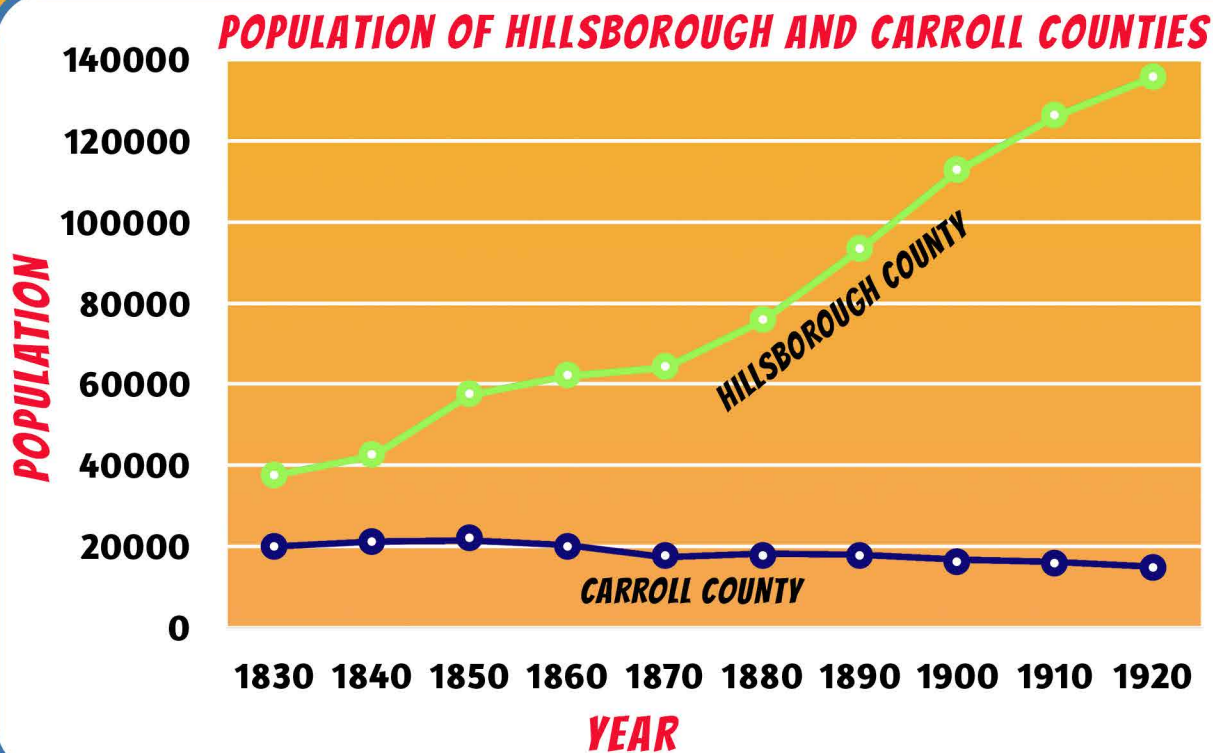
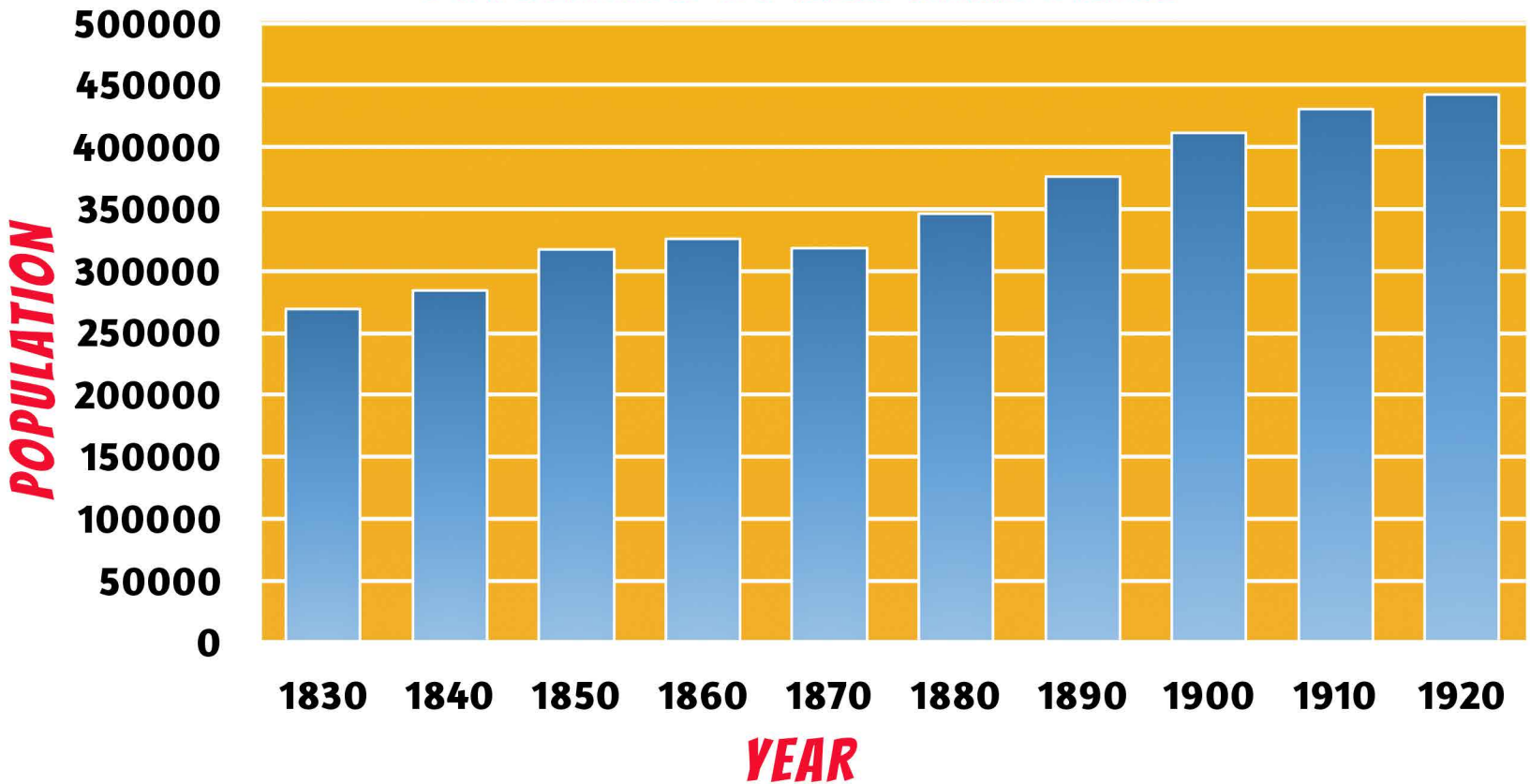


# POPULATION OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

During the Industrial Revolution, the population of New Hampshire changed a lot! Let's take a look at how the number of people living in the Granite State changed from 1830 to 1920.

## POPULATION OF NEW HAMPSHIRE



The Industrial Revolution had a different impact in different places in New Hampshire. This graph shows the population change in two different New Hampshire counties.

Hillsborough County (in **GREEN**) is in the southern part of the state. It has two of New Hampshire's biggest cities, Nashua and Manchester.

Carroll County (in **BLUE**) is in the northeast part of the state. It covers part of the White Mountain and Lakes regions.



1. Write a sentence summarizing the change in New Hampshire's population from 1830-1920. Why do you think the population increased during this time?
2. What do you observe about the populations of Hillsborough County and Carroll County from 1830-1920?
3. Hillsborough County is a more urban county while Carroll County is a more rural county. Does that information help explain the population changes during these years? Why?
4. The "Population of New Hampshire" graph is a bar graph and the "Population of Hillsborough and Carroll Counties" is a line graph. Why were these the best choices for each type of graph?
