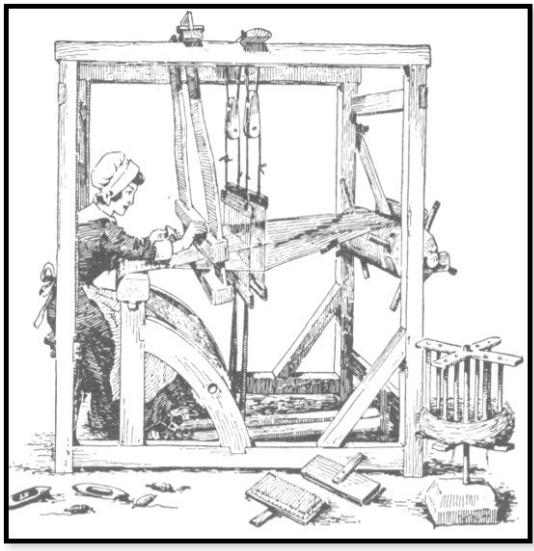


HOW WERE THINGS MADE BEFORE INDUSTRIALIZATION?

This woman is working on a hand loom. She moves the parts of the loom with her hands and by pressing on pedals at her feet.

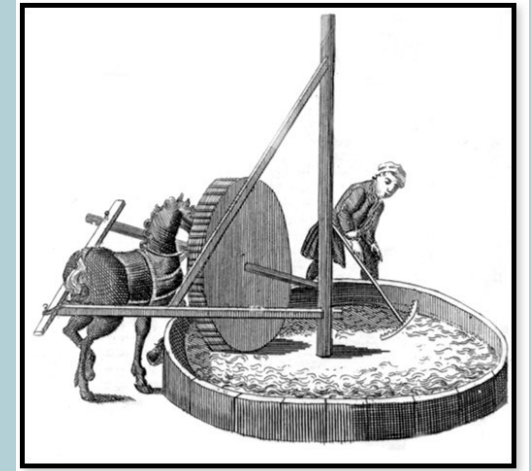


Products Made By Hand
