

### The First Settlers (1600s to 1800s)

People from **Great Britain** made the first European settlements in New Hampshire. After the United States was created, these immigrants expanded the number of towns in New Hampshire.

### The Great Wave (1840s to 1920s)

During the Great Wave, immigrants came from all over **Europe** and **Canada** to New Hampshire. They moved to growing cities to work in new industries.

### The Modern Period (1960s to now)

Immigrants from **Africa**, **Asia**, and **Latin America** come to New Hampshire looking for opportunities like good jobs and education.
