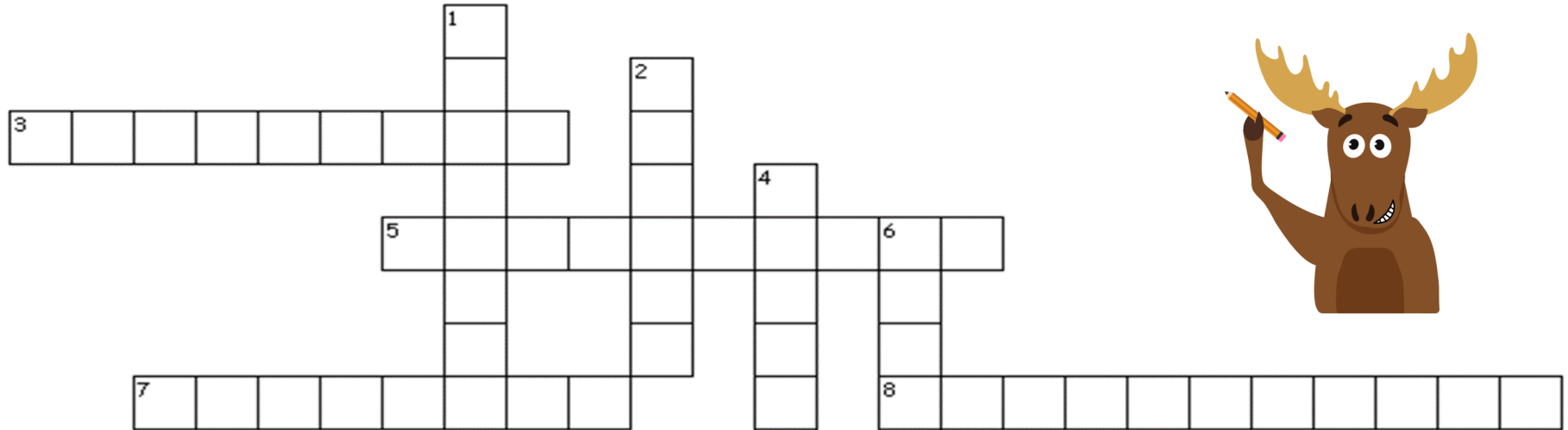


CROSSWORD PUZZLE: TOURISM
