



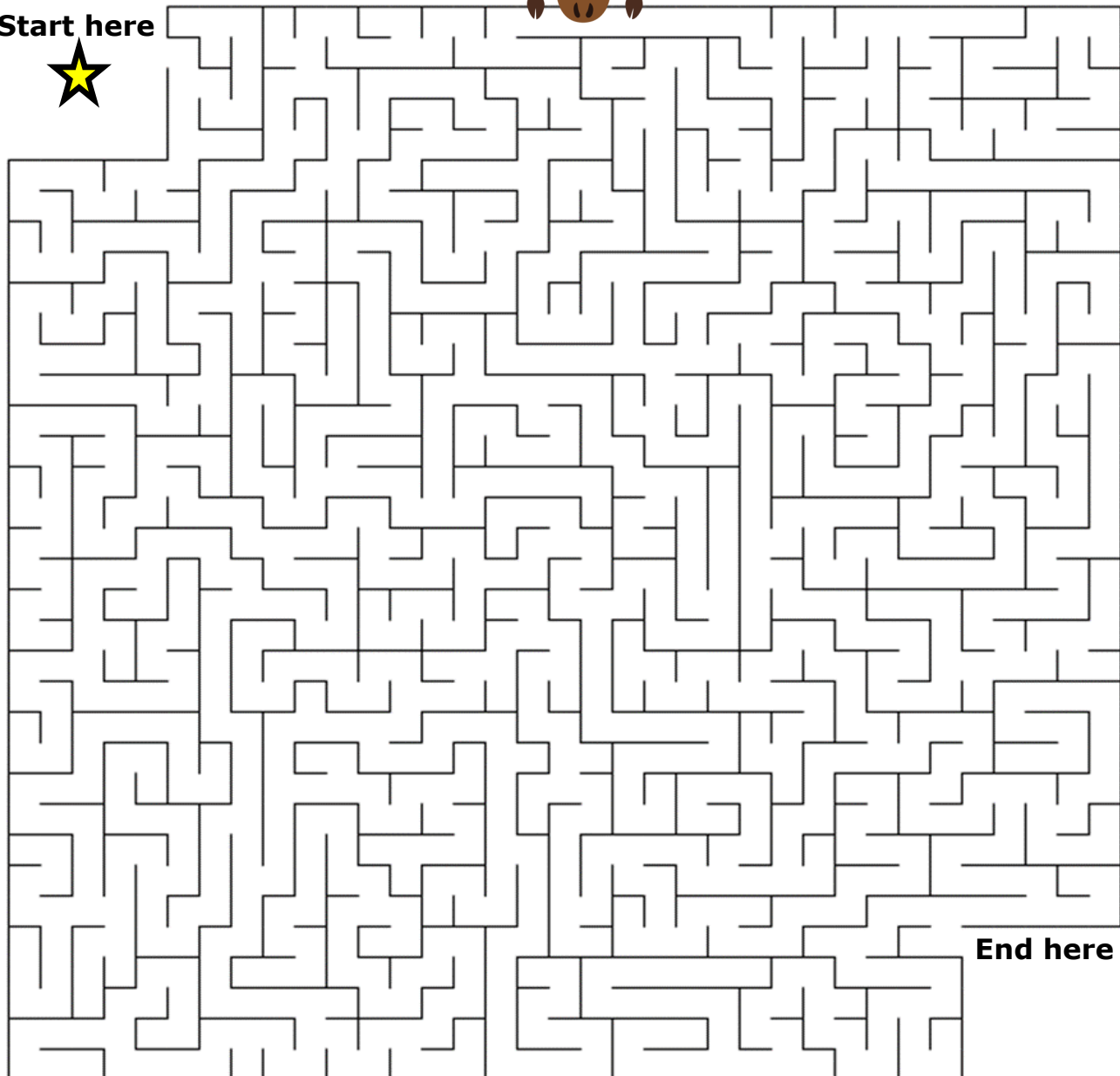
FIND YOUR WAY: CLEANING UP NH'S WATERWAYS
