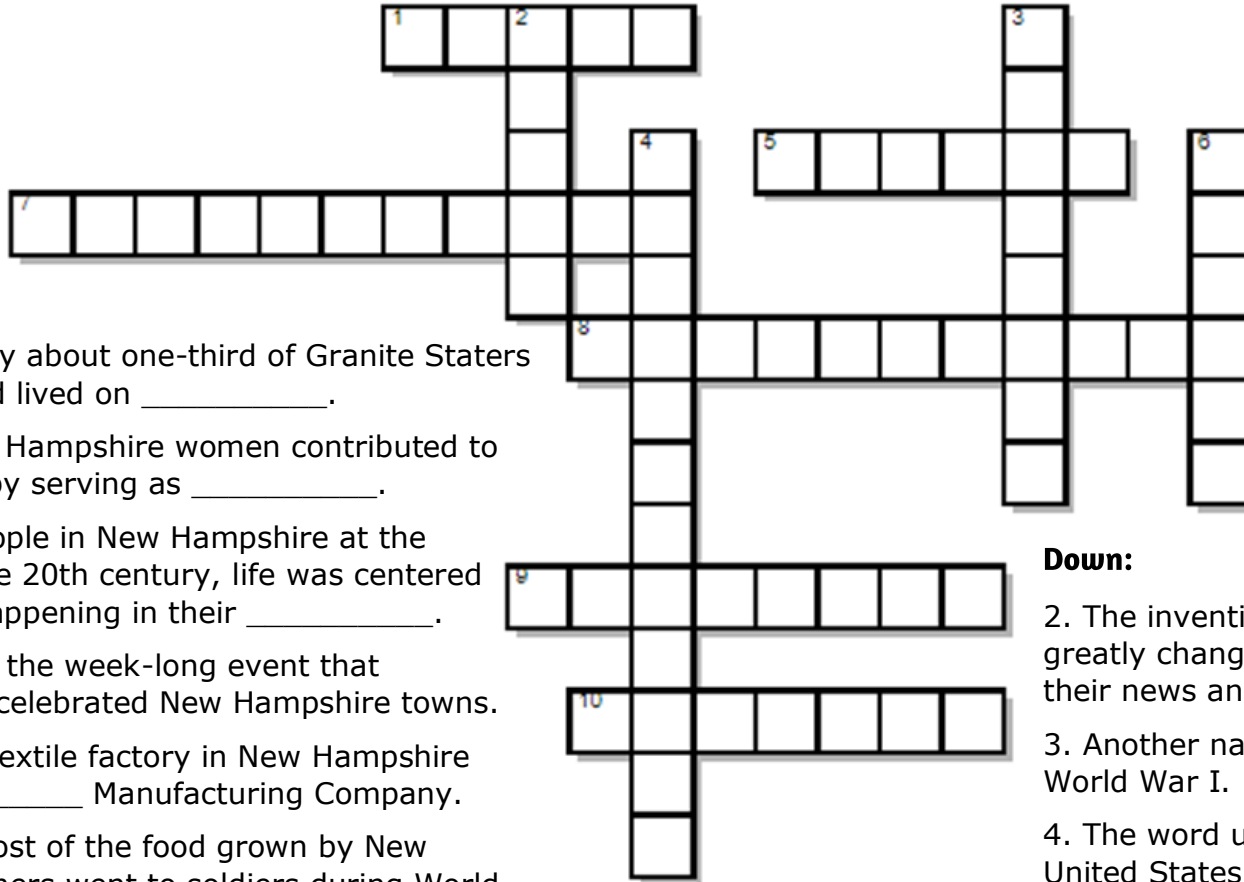




CROSSWORD PUZZLE: EARLY 20TH CENTURY NH
