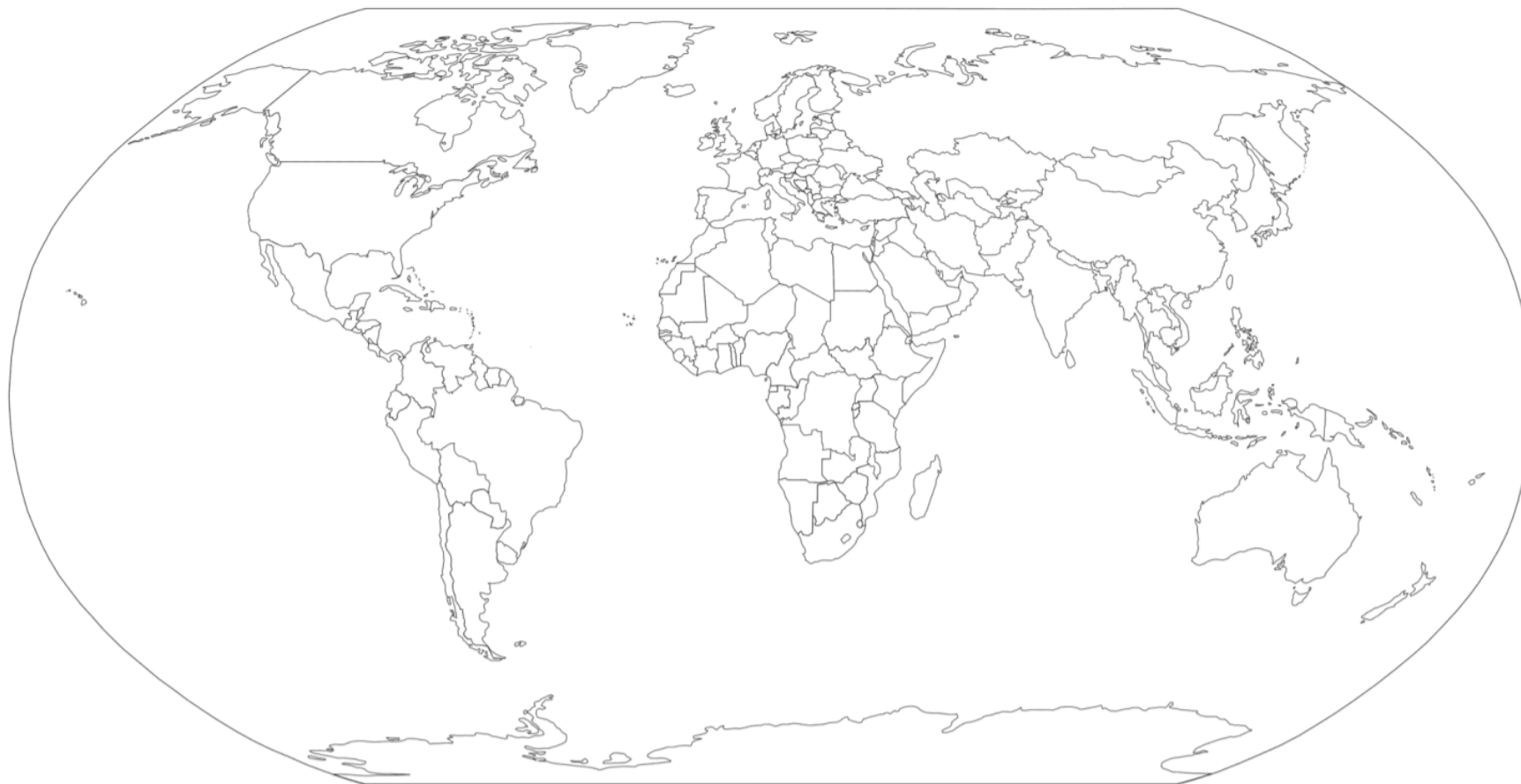

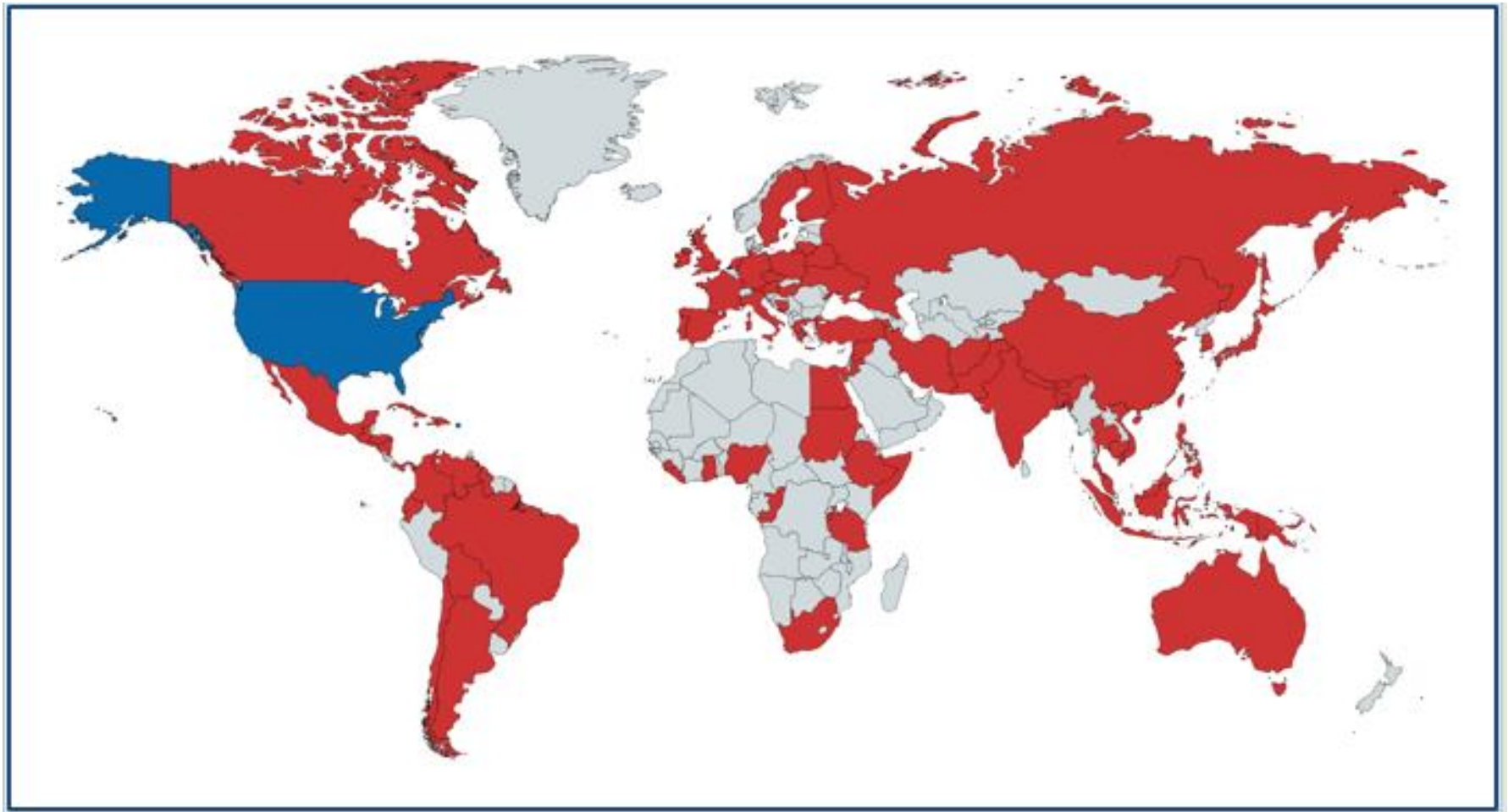
World Map: First Generation Immigrants in New Hampshire
