

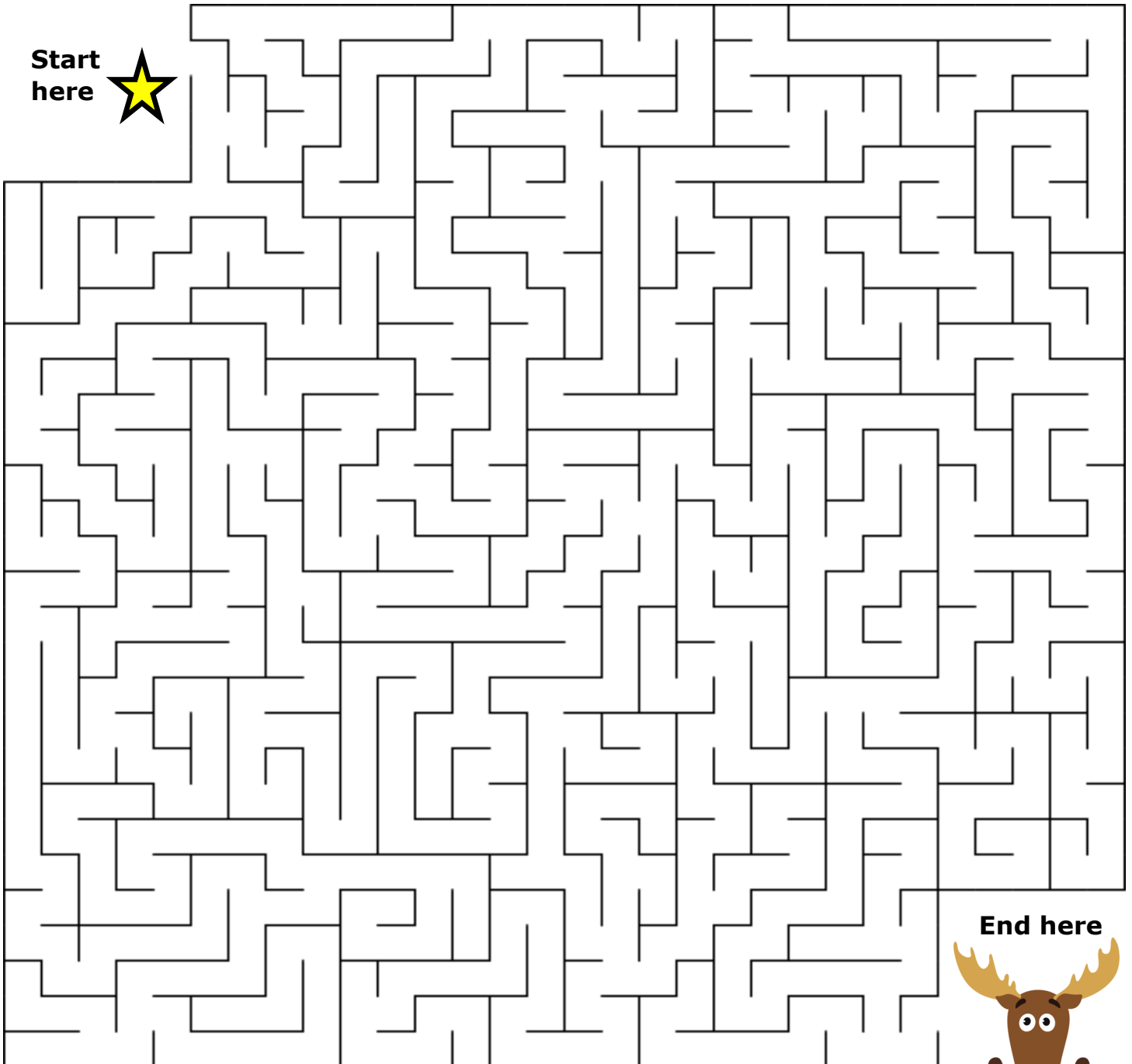


## ***FIND YOUR WAY: BUILDING TURNPIKES***
