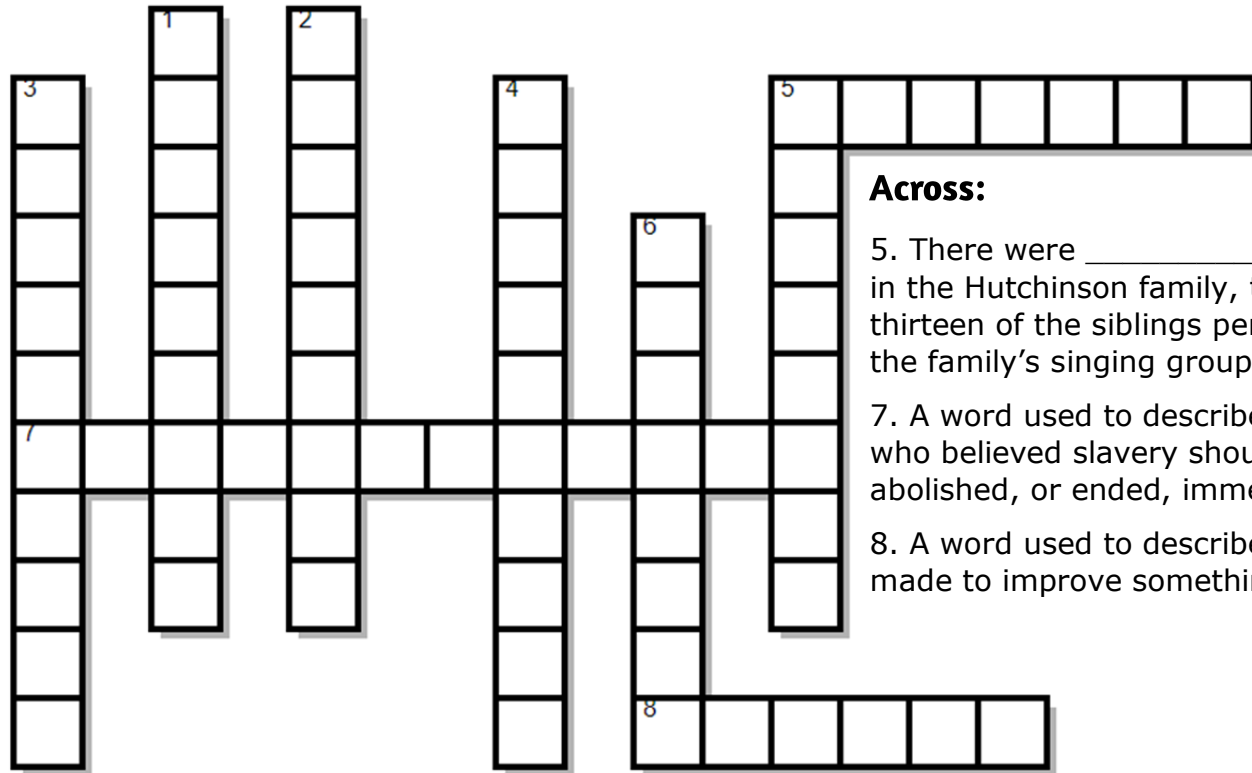




## CROSSWORD PUZZLE: AGE OF REFORM
