## ***CELEBRATE YOUR HERO: ACROSTIC POEM***

An ACROSTIC POEM is a poem where the first letter of each line spells out a word, name, or phrase when it is read vertically. An example:

**S**erious but loyal to his friends

**T**raveled to fight for what he believed

**A**ble to lead soldiers into battle

**R**etired after the war

**K**new when to return to his farm

You can pick the person's first name, last name, or both. (Your poem should have at LEAST five lines.) You can use another piece of paper if you need it.
