Massabesic	Great lake outlet	Massabesic Lake
Monadnock	A mountain standing	Mount Monadnock
Nashua	Halfway	Nashua River; Town of Nashua, which lies halfway between the source and the mouth of the Merrimack River
Ossippee	Pine river	Lake Ossippee
Piscataquog	Great deer place	Piscataquog River
