
## THE AMOSKEAG FLYWHEEL DISASTER OF 1891


Working in factories could be dangerous! Most factory accidents involved individual workers who got their fingers, hands, or arms caught in the machinery.

But on October 15, 1891, there was a big accident at the Amoskeag Manufacturing Company in Manchester. The Big Jumbo Steam Engine exploded, killing 3 workers and injuring 8 more.



The Big Jumbo Steam Engine was a Corliss engine, like the one in this picture. Its was a huge engine that produced enough energy to power machines in four mill buildings. The flywheel was spinning too fast that day. Eventually it spun so fast that it blew apart.





The flywheel disaster was the worst industrial accident in the Amoskeag Company's history.
