DRAW YOUR OWN COMIC: COLLECTING MAPLE SYRUP

In early spring, the Abenaki would drain sap from the many maple trees in New Hampshire and make maple syrup. The process they used is the same way that sap is collected and turned into maple syrup today!

Follow the steps written in each comic strip box and draw what each step looks like.



1. Find a maple tree!

2. Put a wooden tap into the trunk of the maple tree. Then, place a bucket underneath the tap to collect the sap.
